

Kickin' It for Kids
Adult Coed Kickball Tournament
June 28th, 2008 At Community Park in Onalaska, WI
Ages: 18 & Older
Registration Deadline: June 14th, 2008

Tournament Rules [Subject to change]
Teams must be at the tournament by 8:45am to check in.
Start time for first games is 9:00am.

1) THE TEAM

1. A co-ed kickball team consists of 8-12 players-**minimum of 4 female players.**
2. A team may field 8-10 players on defense. A team may have their entire roster in kicking order on offense.
3. Male and female players must alternate in the kicking order from the beginning of the line-up.
4. On defense, each team must have a minimum of 4 women
5. All team members must be at least 18 years of age. ID must be present.

2) THE GAME

1. A game will be five innings **or** thirty minutes in duration (no new innings started after 25 minutes).
2. The ten-run rule will be in effect after the third full inning.
3. The tournament will be a double elimination.
4. Games will take place rain or shine.

3) THE RULES

1. The pitcher is a member of the **kicking** team, and thus pitches to his/her teammates. However, the team on defense is still allowed to place a player at the pitching position for defensive purposes.
2. If the pitcher intentionally interferes with the play of a kicked ball, the ball is ruled dead. The kicker is out and all base runners must return to the base that they occupied at the time of the pitch.
3. If a kicked ball accidentally hits the pitcher, the ball is ruled dead. All base runners must return to the base that they occupied at the time of the pitch without liability of being put out. The pitcher is permitted to deliver the pitch again. No pitch is counted for the ball that hit the pitcher.
4. If a team has only 8 players, they don't have to play a catcher. However, someone from the infield must cover plays at the plate. If a team has 9 or 10, then they must supply the catcher.
5. No walks
6. Each kicker is allowed three pitches.
7. Two foul balls is an out. A foul ball on the third pitch is an out.
8. Base runners may not leave a base before the ball is kicked.
9. A base runner will be ruled out if he/she is hit with the ball at or below the shoulders before reaching base. An attempt to avoid being hit with the ball that results in the base runner being unintentionally hit above the shoulders will result in an out.
10. A kicker must kick the ball behind home plate. Violating this rule results in a strike being called. Violating this rule on the third pitch results in an out.
11. No charging the kicker
12. Bunting is not allowed
13. Catcher must stay behind home plate until the ball is kicked
14. No tie games-tie breaker rules (to be determined)
15. Players are only allowed to play on one team
16. All outfield players must stay in the outfield until ball is kicked
17. No metal cleats
18. No pinch running
19. Teams that are not ready to play on time will forfeit
20. All players must sign a Waiver of Liability the day of the tournament in order to participate

GOOD SPORTSMANSHIP IS EXPECTED

Umpires will not tolerate abuse, verbal or otherwise. Each team will be allowed one warning. The second warning is an ejection of that player. Continued unsportsmanlike conduct will result in the team's ejection from the tournament.
